Daniel J. Meckstroth, Ph.D., is Chief Economist for the Manufacturers Alliance/MAPI. He has been with the Alliance since 1990. Dr. Meckstroth provides comments and analysis on a wide variety of economic issues as they relate to the manufacturing sector and is the primary spokesperson for the Alliance on business conditions and economic matters.
